This student program focuses on developing leadership skills with a "learn by doing" emphasis. The exhilaration of seeing crocodiles in a natural setting, visiting the Daintree Rainforest and Great Barrier Reef, and learning more about themselves and each other within a fundamentals of leadership workshop will produce courage and confidence. An Aboriginal guide will give you their perspective on their rainforest country, and your marine guides will teach you valuable skills for collecting data and contributing to Citizen Science.



Snorkel with sea turtles & visit a Turtle Rehabilitation Centre to meet them up close. Experience the Daintree Rainforest with an Aboriginal guide & hear their stories of connection. Participate in fun activities to learn about your own, & your peers strengths. Give back to community through fun service project & data collection activities.
