OUTDOOR EDUCATION

Building Skills and Overcoming Challenges

Our Outdoor Education program kicked off the term with engaging teambuilding exercises, helping students learn to rely on each other in various challenging situations. They explored team dynamics through Tuckman's stages of group development and learned how to calculate risk in outdoor settings.

A significant highlight was the excursion to Port Noarlunga, focused on human impact and sustainability of coastal areas. Students snorkelled at the reef and kayaked on the Onkaparinga River, with many overcoming their fears of water thanks to the support of their classmates. This experience empowered them to propose solutions to the Onkaparinga Council to mitigate human impact on the environment.

In our mountain biking unit, students spend a day at Fox Creek, developing their skills and focusing on calculated risk-taking. Many were surprised by their achievements, realising their potential through this exhilarating experience.

The class has come together remarkably well, showing strong support for each other and actively engaging in their learning and growth. Their involvement has been a standout feature of the program. Looking ahead, we are planning a hiking camp in Term 2, where students will focus on practical skills such as setting up tents, cooking on trangias, and route planning, further enhancing their teamwork and outdoor abilities.
